

Memorandum of Understanding
between
The General Administration of Civil Aviation of China
and
The Civil Aviation Authority of Zimbabwe
for
the Continued Airworthiness
of the MA60 Aircraft after Delivery to Zimbabwe


This Memorandum of Understanding is an arrangement between the General Administration of Civil Aviation of People's Republic of China and the Civil Aviation Authority of the Republic of Zimbabwe intended to ensure that continued airworthiness of the MA60 is maintained through mutual co-operation.

Any modification after delivery of the aircraft to Zimbabwe will be subject to mutual agreement using information obtained during the type certification process.


For each aircraft delivery, CAAC will issue an individual Export Certificate of Airworthiness and ensure that it is in an airworthy condition for a continued safe operation.

When the service experience in Zimbabwe indicate the existence of an unsafe condition associated with the design, manufacturing or maintenance of the MA60, CAAZ will inform CAAC and CAAC will give expedient attention to the information and take appropriate action to correct the condition.
