- e. The CCAR-129 air carrier shall not conduct operation within the P.R.C if its AOC is invalid.

- f The CCAR-129 air carrier shall not use the services of a pilot in command, nor shall any person act as a pilot in command, in any of the following operations under the authority of these operations specifications, if that person has reached his/her 65th birthday:
- (1) Scheduled international air transportation carrying passengers with multi-engine airplanes having MTOW of more than 5,700kg;
 - (2) Nonscheduled international air transportation with multi-engine airplanes having a passenger-seat configuration of more than 30 seats, excluding each crewmember seat; or with multi-engine airplanes having a payload capacity of more than 3,400kg;
 - (3) All cargo international air transportation with multi-engine airplanes having a payload capacity of more than 3,400kg.
- g. Each flight crewmember employed by the CCAR-129 air carrier shall hold current certificate(s) or license(s), showing that person's ability to perform duties connected with operating that aircraft, for all operations authorized by these operations specifications.
- h. Each maintenance personnel employed by the CCAR-129 air carrier for issuing the maintenance release to service shall hold current certificate(s) or license(s), showing that person's ability to perform duties.
- i. If there are changes to any information in these CAAC-issued operations specifications or to the basis upon which these operations specifications have been issued (as follows), the CCAR-129 air carrier must notify responsible CAAC regional administration in a form and manner acceptable:
- (1) Ownership is changed;
 - (2) AOC is updated, including relevant enforcement actions taken by CAA;
 - (3) Aircrafts listed in A0003, including any information changed in each column;
 - (4) Airports listed in C0070 of this Operations Specifications cease operations;
 - (5) Other information required by CAAC.
- j. These operations specifications are effective for long term, but if the CCAR-129 air carrier has not actually operated in the P.R.C for 12 consecutive months, reassessment and reissuance of these operations specifications are required before reoperation.

The words, phrases, definitions and abbreviations used in these operations specifications are defined as follows:

<u>AIP</u>	Aeronautical Information Publication
<u>AOC</u>	Air Operator Certificate
<u>ATC</u>	Air Traffic Control
<u>CAAC</u>	Civil Aviation Administration of China
<u>CAA</u>	The civil aviation authority which is responsible to issue an AOC to the air operator according to International Civil Aviation Convention.
<u>Refueling Airport</u>	An airport approved as an airport to which flights may be dispatched only for refueling. (F = Refueling)
<u>Regular Airport</u>	An airport approved under scheduled service to a community as the regular stop to that community. (R = Regular)
<u>Alternate Airport</u>	An airport at which an aircraft may land, when a landing at the intended airport becomes inadvisable. (A = Alternate)
<u>Special Airports</u>	Special airports for the purposes of these operations specifications are airports which CAAC has determined due to such items as surrounding terrain, obstructions, or complex approach procedures are special airports requiring special airport qualifications.
<u>Seventh (7th) Freedom</u>	The seventh traffic right.
<u>Wet Lease</u>	Any leasing or other agreement, other than a code-sharing arrangement, in which a lessor such as an air carrier leases an aircraft and at least one flight crewmember to another air carrier (the lessee). A wet lease requires that a written agreement between the lessor and the lessee be executed by authorized officers of the two parties. Either a copy of the lease agreement or a written memorandum of the terms of the lease agreement must be provided to CAAC.
